Specify the output format

Lengths, headings, bullet style, character limits, JSON schema — whatever you actually need.

Iterate, don't restart

Treat the first answer as a draft. Reply with targeted edits (“shorter”, “more direct”, “add a CTA”) instead of writing a new prompt.

Always review the output

AI accelerates drafting; it doesn't replace professional judgment. Verify facts, names, numbers, and anything regulated before you send.
